What's Allowed in a Tool Sharpening repair form?

- A pair of gardening shears
- A pair of garden loppers
- A pair of pruning secateurs
- A pair of lawn mower blades (please bring just the blades)
- A pair of kitchen scissors
- A pair of dress making scissors
- 1 hunting knife
- 1 folding pocket knife
- 1 Swiss army knife
- A cleaver
- 2 kitchen knives
- 1 serrated knife
- 2 chisels
- 1 shovel
- 1 spade
- 1 hand saw
- 1 axe

Please note that if you have more items than what is allowed in <u>1 repair form</u> to be sharpened, you can create another repair form <u>after</u> the first repair form is completed.

Please transport your item safely and responsibly. Do bring your knife or any pointed or sharp edged items in a cardboard sleeve so that it can be reinserted into the sleeve for safe transport.

What we do not sharpen

- Other types of saws.
- Hair trimmers or hair dressing scissors or clippers
- Hedge cutters
